1. Site publisher

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2. Hosting

Retention Only for as long as needed to handle your request; deletion at any time on simple request

Recipients The publisher only. No resale, no sharing, no transfer to third parties.

4. Cookies and trackers

- **Technical session cookie (PHP)**: required for the site to work (e.g. form submission). Duration: the visit

only. It does not personally identify you.

- **Google Fonts:** the site uses fonts hosted by Google (*fonts.googleapis.com*). When a page loads, your IP address may be transmitted to Google Inc. This is based on legitimate interest (proper display of the site). More information: policies.google.com/privacy.
- No advertising cookie, no analytics, no social network collects data on this site.

5. Your GDPR rights

Under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the French “Informatique et Libertés” law, you have the following rights over your data:

- **Right of access:** know which personal data is held about you;
- **Right to rectification:** have inaccurate data corrected;
- **Right to erasure** (“right to be forgotten”): ask for your data to be deleted;
- **Right to object and to restriction** of processing;
- **Right to data portability.**
